

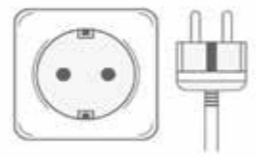

### DAY 1: Departure

### DAY 2: Arrive Iceland - Keflavik (-)

### DAY 3: Southwestern Iceland (B/L/-)

After breakfast, we'll visit the Golden Circle of Iceland which consist of 3 hot spots: **Thingvellir National Park**, **Geysir Fountain**, and **Gullfoss Waterfall**. Afterwards, we'll check into our hotel and have aurora hunting if the weather conditions is fine.



### DAY 4: South Iceland (B/L/-)

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll visit the popular **Seljalandfoss Cave Waterfall** and **Skogafoss Rainbow Waterfall**. Then, we'll explore the **Plane Wreck** and **Black Sand Beach**, both known for unique photo opportunities. We'll end the day by checking into a suburban hotel with private bathrooms, and if the sky is clear, we'll watch for the Northern Lights.



### DAY 5: South Iceland (B/L/-)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then proceed to two activities: **Blue Ice Cave exploration (Nov-Mac)** or **Glacier Walk on Sólheimajökull (Apr-Oct)**. We'll then visit **Jokulsarloon** and **Diamond Beach**, known for their natural beauty, before checking into a suburban hotel with private bathrooms and the chance to spot the Northern Lights if the sky is clear. *\*Please note that both Glacier Walk & Ice Cave Exploration requires 3 hours of period including preparation.*

### DAY 6: Southeast Iceland (B/L/-)

After breakfast at hotel, we will go to **Vestrahorn sky mirror** photo shooting. Next destination will be East Coast Ocean View Point and Reindeer Photo Hunting (Highest possibility in March) and Road side waterfall. Check into Hotel at suburban area with private bathroom.

### DAY 7: Southeast Iceland (B/L/-)

After breakfast, we'll head to **Myvatn Lake** to explore craters with scenic views. Next, we'll visit the **Namaskard Geothermal Field**, and if the road allows, we may see **Viti Crater** and **Dettifoss Waterfall**. We'll then check into a suburban hotel with private bathrooms and have a chance to spot the Northern Lights if the sky is clear.



### DAY 8: Northeast Iceland - Akureyri (B/L/-)

Breakfast at hotel. Then start our journey to **Godafoss Waterfall**, one of Iceland's true pearls and one of the biggest waterfalls in Iceland. Then we will move on to **Akureyri** downtown and Christmas House. Hotel at suburban area with private bathroom.



### DAY 9: West Iceland (B/L/-)

After breakfast, we'll hike **Grabrok Volcano Crater**, visit **Barnafoss Waterfall**, and check into a suburban hotel with private bathrooms.



### DAY 10: West Iceland (B/L/-)

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll explore the must-visit **Kirkjufellsfoss**, known for its distinctive hat-shaped mountain. Our journey continues to **Arnarstapi**, **Gatklettur View Point**, **Arch Rock Cape**, and the iconic **Black Church** set amidst lava rock. We'll then return to our suburban hotel with private bathrooms.



### DAY 11: Reykjavik (B/L/-)

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll embark on a city tour. Our first stop is **Hallgrímskirkja Church**, a modern cathedral with a 73m-high tower inspired by Icelandic traditions. We'll then visit the **Rainbow Walkway**, **Sun Voyager**, and **Harpa**. Later, we'll head to the **Blue Lagoon** for a relaxing soak in geothermal waters, offering stunning views of the Iceland's rugged terrain. Finally, we'll check into a hotel near the airport.



### DAY 12: Keflavik - Transit City (B)

Breakfast at hotel then transfer to Airport. Leaving Iceland
