

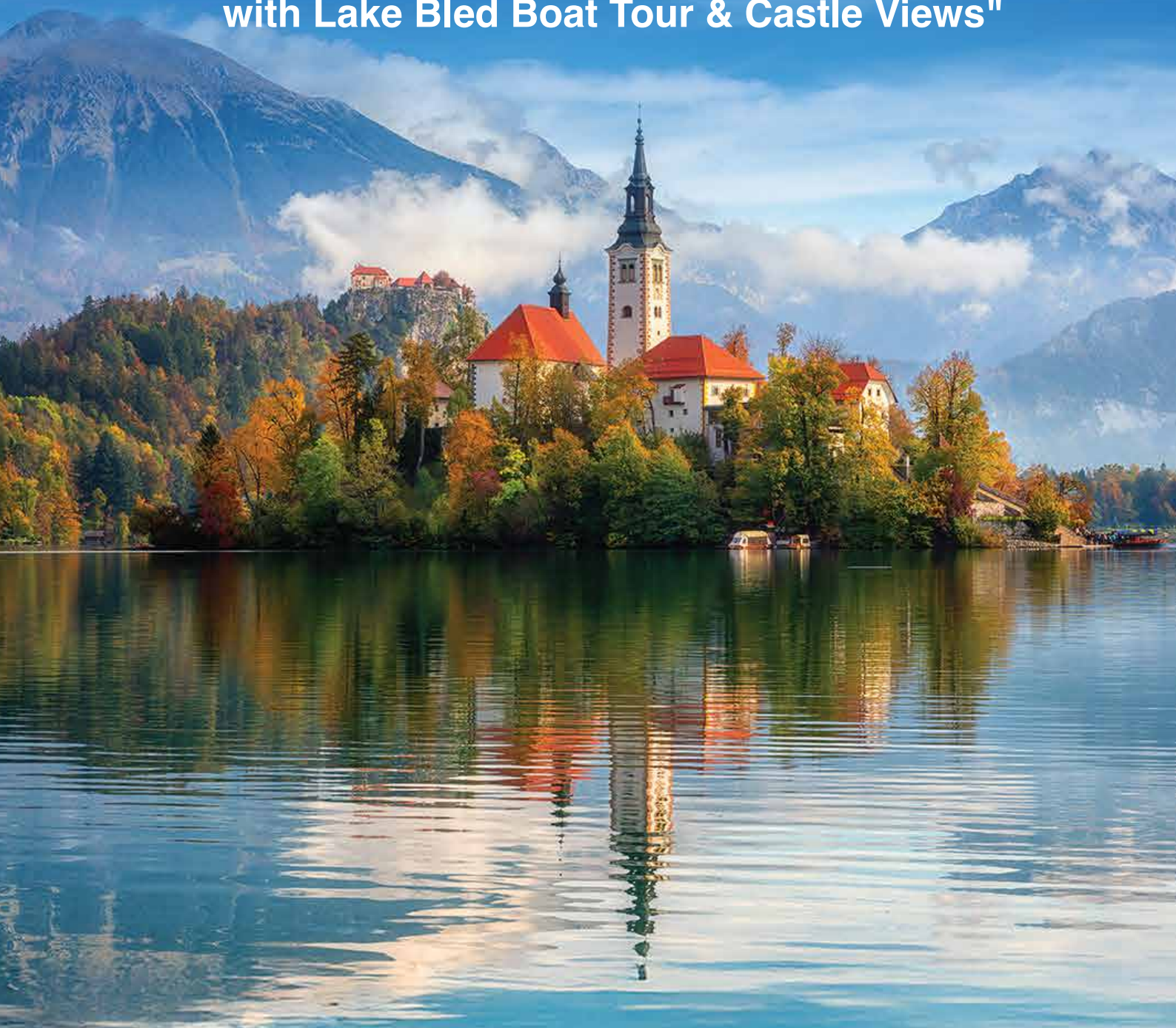

Day 1: Departure from KUL

Day 2: Arrival at Zagreb (B+D)

Upon arrival in Zagreb, immerse yourself in the city's rich history and culture with a walking tour. Begin at the **[National Theater]**, a grand architectural masterpiece, before strolling through the **[Upper and Lower Town]**, where cobble streets and historic buildings paint a picture of Zagreb's past. Admire the colorful roof of **[St. Mark's Church]** from the outside, then pass by the **[Mimara Museum]**, an elegant neoclassical building housing an impressive art collection. Stop for photos at the **[Cathedral of the Assumption]**, one of Croatia's tallest landmarks, before visiting the **[Stone Gate]**, a significant historical and religious site. Continue to **[Ban Jelačić Square]**, the lively heart of the city, and pass by the medieval **[Lotrščak Tower]**, once part of Zagreb's fortifications. Conclude the tour with a glimpse of the **[Zagreb Mosque]**, the largest Islamic place of worship in Croatia. Spend the night in Zagreb.



Day 3: Zagreb – Plitvice – Bihać – Sarajevo (B+D)

Depart from Zagreb and head to one of Croatia's most breathtaking natural wonders, **[Plitvice National Park]**. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, this park is famous for its cascading waterfalls and interconnected turquoise lakes, offering a mesmerizing experience. Continue to **[Bihać Jajce Waterfall]**, a picturesque setting where nature and history intertwine. Afterward, explore the historic town of **[Travnik]**, once the capital of the Ottoman province of Bosnia. Arrive in **[Sarajevo]**, Bosnia and Herzegovina's fascinating capital, for an overnight stay.



Day 4: Sarajevo (B+D)

Begin the day with a visit to the **[War Tunnel Museum]**, an essential site that played a crucial role during the Siege of Sarajevo. This underground passage was a lifeline for residents during the Bosnian War, making it a place of deep historical significance. Continue with a walking tour through the city, where Ottoman and Austro-Hungarian influences blend seamlessly with modern life. Stroll past [mosques, churches, and bazaars], and experience the city's diverse heritage.



Day 5: Sarajevo – Mostar / Međugorje (B+D)

Travel to **[Mostar]**, a city known for its stunning Ottoman-era architecture and deeply moving history. The highlight is the world-famous **[Stari Most (Old Bridge)]**, a UNESCO-listed landmark that has stood as a symbol of unity for centuries. Wander through the cobble streets of **[Mostar Old Town]**, where traditional shops and cafés line the riverbanks. Later, continue to **[Međugorje]**, one of the most significant Catholic pilgrimage sites in the world.

Day 6: Mostar / Međugorje – Dubrovnik – Split – Zadar

(B+D)

Embark on a journey to [Dubrovnik], famously known as the "Pearl of the Adriatic." Walk along the [Ancient City Walls], offering breathtaking views of the city and the shimmering Adriatic Sea. Explore the historical streets, stopping at the [Church of St. Blaise], [Sponza Palace], and the grand [Pile Gate], which serves as the entrance to the [Old Town], a UNESCO World Heritage Site. See [Onofrio's Fountain], a 15th-century water supply system, and admire the city's medieval charm.

Continue to [Split], home to the spectacular [Diocletian's Palace], one of the most well-preserved Roman monuments in the world. Explore the [Cathedral of Saint Domnius] and stroll along the [Riva Waterfront], where modern cafés meet ancient history. Travel to [Zadar], a coastal gem where the [Roman Forum] and [Church of St. Donatus] showcase the city's deep-rooted history.



Day 7: Zadar – Postojna – Ljubljana

(B+D)

Visit the spectacular [Postojna Cave], one of Europe's most impressive cave systems, filled with mesmerizing stalactites and underground passages. Then, cross into Slovenia and explore [Ljubljana], the charming capital known for its fairy-tale architecture and lively atmosphere. Stroll along the [Ljubljanica River Canal], walk across the famous [Triple Bridge], and admire the beauty of [Ljubljana Old Town]. Take a moment at [Prešeren Square], a vibrant cultural hub, before stopping for photos at the [Franciscan Church] and [Cathedral of St. Nicholas].



Day 8: Ljubljana – Bled – Zagreb

(B+D)

Journey to the picturesque [Lake Bled], a postcard-perfect destination surrounded by emerald waters and alpine scenery. Enjoy a traditional [Pletna boat ride] across the lake, offering a scenic view of [Bled Castle], perched on a cliff. Visit [St. Mary's Church], a charming pilgrimage site located on [Bled Island], before returning to [Zagreb] for your final night in Croatia.



Day 9: Zagreb – Kuala Lumpur

(B)

Bid farewell to the mesmerizing landscapes of Croatia and board the flight back to Kuala Lumpur. This unforgettable African wildlife photography expedition will undoubtedly be a cherished memory for a lifetime.

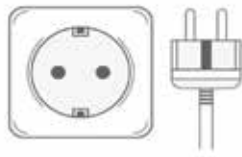

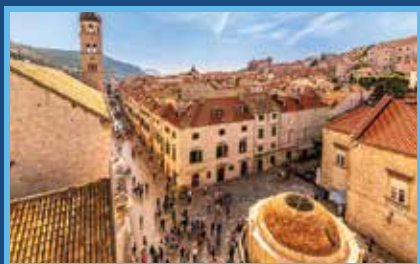

第 1 天: 从吉隆坡出发

第 2 天: 抵达萨格勒布

(早+晚餐)

抵达萨格勒布后, 开启一场深入城市历史与文化的徒步之旅。首先参观宏伟壮观的【国家剧院】, 然后漫步于【上城和下城】, 欣赏鹅卵石街道和历史悠久的建筑, 感受萨格勒布的昔日风情。接着, 前往【圣马克教堂】, 欣赏其色彩斑斓的屋顶外观。随后经过【米马拉博物馆】, 这座典雅的新古典主义建筑内珍藏着丰富的艺术收藏品。游览萨格勒布的标志性地标【圣母升天大教堂】, 并在【石门】驻足, 这是当地重要的历史和宗教遗址。随后前往热闹的【耶拉奇奇广场】, 感受城市的活力气息, 并途经曾是萨格勒布防御工事一部分的【洛特尔察克塔】。最后, 瞥见克罗地亚最大的伊斯兰礼拜场所——【萨格勒布清真寺】。夜宿萨格勒布。



第 3 天: 萨格勒布 - 普利特维采 - 比哈奇 - 萨拉热窝

(早+晚餐)

从萨格勒布出发, 前往克罗地亚最令人惊叹的自然奇观之一——【普利特维采湖国家公园】。该公园被联合国教科文组织列为世界遗产, 以层层叠叠的瀑布和相互连接的碧蓝湖泊闻名, 美不胜收。随后, 前往【比哈奇雅伊采瀑布】, 这里自然与历史交融, 景色迷人。之后, 探访历史悠久的【特拉夫尼克】, 曾是奥斯曼帝国波斯尼亚省的首府。晚上抵达波斯尼亚和黑塞哥维那的首都——【萨拉热窝】, 入住酒店休息。



第 4 天: 萨拉热窝

(早+晚餐)

上午参观【战争隧道博物馆】, 这座博物馆展示了萨拉热窝围城战期间的关键生命通道, 具有重要的历史意义。随后, 开启城市徒步之旅, 沿途欣赏【清真寺、教堂和集市】, 感受奥斯曼与奥匈帝国文化交融的独特魅力。



第 5 天: 萨拉热窝 - 莫斯塔尔 / 梅祖戈耶

(早+晚餐)

前往【莫斯塔尔】, 这里因奥斯曼时期的建筑和深刻的历史故事而闻名。重点参观世界著名的【斯塔里莫斯特 (古桥)】, 这座联合国教科文组织认证的桥梁象征着团结与希望。随后, 漫步【莫斯塔尔老城区】, 感受古朴的石板路与河岸边的传统商铺和咖啡馆。之后, 继续前往著名的天主教朝圣地——【梅祖戈耶】。

第 6 天: 莫斯塔尔 / 梅祖戈耶 – 杜布罗夫尼克 – 斯普利特 – 扎达尔 (早+晚餐)

今日行程从“亚得里亚海明珠”【杜布罗夫尼克】开始。首先登上【古城墙】，俯瞰城市与蔚蓝大海的壮丽景色。步入历史悠久的街道，探访【圣布莱斯教堂】、【斯庇扎宫】及宏伟的【皮勒门】，它是进入联合国教科文组织认证【旧城区】的主要入口。参观【奥诺弗里奥喷泉】，这座 15 世纪建造的供水系统至今仍保存完好，见证了城市悠久的历史。

接着前往【斯普利特】，参观雄伟的【戴克里先宫】，这座宫殿是世界上保存最完好的罗马建筑之一。随后，游览【圣杜耶大教堂】，漫步于【里瓦海滨长廊】，欣赏古老与现代交织的风景。最后，抵达【扎达尔】，探索古罗马遗址【罗马广场】及历史悠久的【圣多纳图斯教堂】。



第 7 天: 扎达尔 – 波斯托伊那 – 卢布尔雅那 (早+晚餐)

今日首站前往【波斯托伊那洞穴】，这是欧洲最壮观的地下溶洞之一，拥有奇幻的钟乳石和错综复杂的地下通道。随后跨境进入斯洛文尼亚，游览充满童话色彩的首都【卢布尔雅那】。漫步于【卢布尔雅那察河运河】，经过著名的【三重桥】，感受老城区的迷人风情。来到热闹的【普列舍仁广场】，拍摄【方济各会教堂】与【圣尼古拉斯大教堂】的美景。



第 8 天: 卢布尔雅那 – 布莱德 – 萨格勒布 (早+晚餐)

今日前往风景如画的【布莱德湖】，湖水碧绿，四周环绕着阿尔卑斯山，宛如童话世界。乘坐传统【普列特纳木船】泛舟湖上，眺望悬崖上的【布莱德城堡】。登上【布莱德岛】，参观迷人的【圣玛利亚教堂】，感受宁静祥和的氛围。傍晚返回【萨格勒布】，迎接克罗地亚之旅的最后一晚。



第 9 天: 萨格勒布 – 吉隆坡 (早餐)

告别迷人的克罗地亚美景，搭乘航班返回吉隆坡。这次难忘的欧洲之旅，将成为一生珍藏的美好回忆。

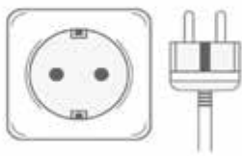
