第一天: 从吉隆坡出发

第一天: 抵达内罗毕

抵达机场后, 由导游接机, 随后前往酒店休息, 调整时差, 养精蓄锐, 为即将展开的非洲野生动物之旅做好准备。

第二天: 达罗毕 - 安博塞利国家公园 (约4-5小时, 240公里) (早+午+晚餐)

早餐后, 驱车前往著名的**【安博塞利国家公园】**, 这片大草原以壮观的象群和远方巍峨的【乞力马扎罗山】**背景闻名。抵达后入住酒店, 享用午餐, 稍作休息。下午正式开启观察野生动物之旅, 在辽阔的草原上寻找成群的大象, 并在最佳角度拍摄它们与雪山相互辉映的震撼画面。



第三天: 安博塞利 - 纳瓦沙湖 (约5-6小时, 340公里) (早+午+晚餐)

清晨时分, 再次乘车进入公园, 趁着日出时光拍摄晨曦中的野生动物, 捕捉它们最活跃的瞬间。Safari结束后返回酒店享用早餐, 随后驱车前往风景秀丽的**【纳瓦沙湖】**。抵达后, 享用午餐, 并展开乘船游湖的体验。在湖面上, 可以近距离观察河马浮游水面, 欣赏飞翔而过的鱼鹰以及其他湖区特有的水鸟, 感受湖泊生态的生机勃勃。



第四天: 纳瓦沙湖 - 纳库鲁湖 - 纳瓦沙湖 (往返约2-3小时, 150公里) (早+午+晚餐)

早餐后, 启程前往以丰富鸟类生态闻名的**【纳库鲁湖国家公园】**, 这里是肯尼亚最重要的犀牛保护区之一。上午的观察野生动物之行将带领我们寻找珍稀的白犀牛和黑犀牛, 同时还有机会遇见狮子、长颈鹿以及其他非洲野生动物。午餐后返回纳瓦沙湖, 下午可以自由活动, 选择骑马或徒步探访【新月岛】**, 在湖畔绿意盎然的步道上近距离接触斑马、长颈鹿等温和的草食动物, 享受宁静悠闲的自然氛围。



第五天: 纳瓦沙湖 - 马赛马拉 (约5-6小时, 250公里) (早+午+晚餐)


早餐后, 驱车前往非洲最负盛名的野生动物天堂——【马赛马拉保护区】。这片广阔的草原孕育了世界上最密集的野生动物种群, 每年吸引着无数摄影师和探险家。抵达后, 入住酒店并享用午餐。下午, 我们将开启观察野生动物之行, 深入大草原寻找狮子、猎豹、大象、角马等野生动物, 感受这片土地的原始魅力。

第六天: 马赛马拉

(早+午+晚餐)

清晨时分, 再次乘坐越野车进入保护区, 追踪晨曦中的野生动物。清晨的光线柔和, 为摄影爱好者提供了绝佳的拍摄机会。返回酒店后, 享用早餐, 随后可以自由活动或在酒店休息。下午继续展开Safari, 欣赏草原上的生态奇观。7月正值**【角马大迁徙】**的季节, 幸运的话, 可以目睹成千上万只角马跨越马拉河的壮观场面, 这无疑是大自然最震撼的奇迹之一。



第七天: 马赛马拉

(早+午+晚餐)

今天将是全天观察野生动物之行, 深入探索【**马赛马拉国家保护区**】的核心区域, 重点寻找非洲五霸——狮子、花豹、大象、犀牛和水牛, 感受真正的狂野非洲。此外, 还可***自费**选择参加额外的文化和探索体验, 例如探访【**马赛村**】, 与马赛族人交流, 了解他们独特的文化、传统和生活方式。另一项***自费**推荐的体验是乘坐【**热气球Safari**】** (需提前预订), 在黎明时分缓缓升空, 俯瞰沐浴在晨光中的无垠大草原, 感受无与伦比的壮丽景色。



第八天: 马赛马拉 - 内罗毕 (约5-6小时, 265公里)

(早+午+晚餐)

清晨, 我们将进行最后一次观察野生动物之行, 抓住最后的机会拍摄这片壮美草原上的野生动物。早餐后, 驱车返回内罗毕。抵达后, 可根据航班时间选择市区游览, 深入了解肯尼亚的历史与文化。晚餐特别安排在著名的**【**百兽宴**】餐厅, 品尝独特的烤肉大餐, 为此次旅程画上完美的句号。若时间允许, 还可选择参观【**长颈鹿中心 (Giraffe Center)**】, 与优雅长颈鹿亲密互动, 或前往【**内罗毕国家博物馆**】**, 深入了解肯尼亚丰富的自然与人文历史。



第九天: 内罗毕 - 吉隆坡

告别肯尼亚这片神奇的土地, 搭乘航班返回吉隆坡。此次难忘的非洲野生动物摄影之旅, 将成为一生中珍贵的回忆。







Day 1: Departure from KUL

Day 2: Arrival at Nairobi

Arrive at Nairobi, where the guide will meet and assist with the transfer to the hotel. Take this time to rest, adjust to the time zone, and recharge in preparation for the exciting African wildlife adventure ahead.

Day 3: Nairobi - Amboseli National Park (Approx. 4-5 hours, 240km) (B+L+D)

After breakfast, drive to the renowned [Amboseli National Park], famous for its breathtaking elephant herds set against the backdrop of the majestic [Mount Kilimanjaro]. Upon arrival, check in at the hotel and enjoy lunch, followed by a short rest. In the afternoon, embark on a thrilling safari across the vast plains, capturing stunning photographs of elephants silhouetted against Africa's highest peak.



Day 3: Amboseli - Lake Naivasha (Approx. 5-6 hours, 340km) (B+L+D)

At dawn, venture back into the park to capture the magical sunrise and witness the wildlife at its most active. After the morning safari, return to the hotel for breakfast before setting off for the picturesque [Lake Naivasha]. Upon arrival, enjoy lunch and then embark on a **boat safari**, where you can observe hippos basking in the water, watch African fish eagles soar above, and marvel at the diverse birdlife that thrives in the lake's rich ecosystem.



Day 4: Lake Naivasha - Lake Nakuru - Lake Naivasha (Round trip approx. 2-3 hours, 150km) (B+L+D)

After breakfast, head to [Lake Nakuru National Park], one of Kenya's key rhino sanctuaries and a paradise for birdwatchers. The morning safari will focus on spotting the rare **white and black rhinos**, as well as lions, giraffes, and other iconic African wildlife. After lunch, return to Lake Naivasha for an afternoon of leisure. You may select an ***optional** program for a **horseback safari** or a **guided walk on Crescent Island**, where you can encounter zebras and giraffes up close in a serene, natural setting.



Day 5: Lake Naivasha - Maasai Mara (Approx. 5-6 hours, 250km) (B+L+D)

After breakfast, journey to the legendary [Maasai Mara National Reserve], one of the most celebrated wildlife sanctuaries in Africa. This vast savanna is home to an extraordinary concentration of wildlife, attracting photographers and explorers from around the world. Upon arrival, check in at the lodge and enjoy lunch before setting out on an afternoon safari, searching for lions, cheetahs, elephants, wildebeests, and other incredible creatures in their natural habitat.

Day 6: Maasai Mara

(B+L+D)

Early morning, embark on another safari to capture the golden sunrise over the savanna, offering ideal conditions for photography. Return to the lodge for breakfast, followed by free time to relax or explore the surroundings. In the afternoon, continue the adventure with another thrilling safari, witnessing the raw beauty of nature. July marks the season of **[the Great Migration]**, offering a once-in-a-lifetime chance to witness thousands of wildebeests crossing the Mara River—a breathtaking natural spectacle.



Day 7: Maasai Mara

(B+L+D)

Spend the entire day on safari, venturing deep into **the heart of Maasai Mara National Reserve** in search of Africa's "Big Five"—lion, leopard, elephant, rhino, and buffalo. In addition to game drives, you may select the ***optional** experiences include a visit to a **[Maasai village]**, where you can interact with the Maasai people and learn about their unique culture, traditions, and way of life. Another unforgettable **e*optional** xperience is the **[Hot Air Balloon Safari]** (advance booking required), offering a breathtaking aerial view of the savanna at sunrise, followed by a champagne breakfast upon landing.



Day 8: Maasai Mara - Nairobi (Approx. 5-6 hours, 265km)

(B+L+D)

Begin the day with a **final morning safari**, making the most of the last opportunities to photograph the wildlife of Maasai Mara. After breakfast, depart for Nairobi. Upon arrival, enjoy a city tour based on flight schedules, gaining deeper insights into Kenya's rich history and culture. For a memorable farewell dinner, savor a feast at the famous **[Carnivore Restaurant]**, known for its exotic grilled meats. If time permits, visit the **[Giraffe Center]** for a close encounter with the elegant Rothschild giraffes or explore the **[Nairobi National Museum]**, showcasing Kenya's fascinating natural and cultural heritage.



Day 9: Nairobi - Kuala Lumpur

Bid farewell to the mesmerizing landscapes of Kenya and board the flight back to Kuala Lumpur. This unforgettable African wildlife photography expedition will undoubtedly be a cherished memory for a lifetime.


